

How Do I See The REPORT Online?

Frequently Asked Questions

• When will this week's issue be online?

We post the issue as soon as it's printed, even before it's back in our offices in Shelbyville.

That's every Monday of every week (except for our shutdown time at Christmas). Depending upon the size of that week's paper and how smooth our lock process goes, this could be anywhere from noon to four o'clock. We know you're waiting on it. We promise to hurry!

What is Adobe Reader and how do I get it?

If you don't have adobe reader, you may go to the adobe website and download the free reader by going to www.adobe.com/products/reader.

Or your computer may prompt you to do so automatically.

• I've downloaded the PDF, how do I make it bigger?

Look at your tool bar for the percentage it is currently on your screen. You can click on the small triangle next to the percentage and then select a larger percentage. We would suggest starting at 200%. You can also use the View menu at the top of the page and select Zoom In to increase the size of the page in small increments. Continue to Zoom In until the page is the size you

Where do I start?

In the left hand column, choose The Report Online. You can then select either Saddle Horse Report or Horse World. If you select Saddle Horse Report, the three most recent issue dates will appear across the top of the middle white part of your screen. Click once on the issue date of your choice and it

breaks down the paper into five page sections. Move your cursor down this list and each five page section breaks down to name the contents of each page for you. Click once on the page of your choice and it will appear on your screen.

If you'd like to see the page larger than it is within the website, you can click on View Page As PDF and it will download the PDF file to your computer. From here you can use Adobe Reader to View the page at a larger size (200% works nicely) or zoom in on particular parts of the page.

If you'd like to see recent Horse World issues, click on Horse World in green to the right after choosing The Report Online. The two most recent issues of Horse World will appear in red across the top of the middle white part of your screen. Select individual pages for Horse World just as you would for Saddle Horse Report.

One significant different, page 1 in Saddle Horse Report is the front cover. Page 1 in Horse World is the first inside page. The four covers of Horse World are featured as the last four pages on the list from that issue.



If you'd prefer, you can access The Report Online directly from the Main Home Page of the site. Locate the Latest Issues directly on the home page and select the issue of your choice. Small thumbnails of each page will appear across the top of your screen and you can browse through these by clicking once on each page to see it larger at the bottom of the screen.
