RULES AND REGULATIONS

SHOW OFFICE HOURS: *Office will close one hour before each performance. Entries for classes within a performance should be made prior to that closing. Check posted hours for additional closings.*

\$35 CHARGE FOR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES: Entries not containing all necessary documents to verify eligibility for horse/rider/owner/trainer/handler will be considered incomplete. Copies of registration papers showing proof of current ownership or lease, copies of current USEF, ASHA and AHHA membership cards must accompany entry blanks, which must include the REQUIRED three signatures and complete addresses for owners and trainers.

OPEN CHECK: To facilitate office procedures, all exhibitors/trainers are required to leave a blank signed check in the show office before numbers will be released.

REFUNDS: Exhibitors cancelling entries after closing date without a vet certificate shall forfeit their entry fees. ***No Refund Of Stall Rent, Office Or Federation Fees.*** No refunds during show.

FAILURE TO ENTER/SCRATCH: A \$25 fine is charged to any exhibitor who fails to enter or scratch an entry at least one hour prior to the start of performance in which entry would compete.

ARRIVAL: Stalls are available after 8am, Tuesday, March 28.

EARLY ARRIVAL FEE: If permitted, early arrivals are charged \$25 per stall, whether for set-up or horse occupancy.

STABLING: 10' x 10' x 7' high portable metal stalls have 4' poly lower panels (side panels are solid, back panel has 11" wide horizontal grid containing two 2.5" wide horizontal openings 16" up from stall bottom); upper portion of stall has 2.5" diameter horizontal bars spaced 5" apart. Aisles are 10' wide, with 12 stalls on each side. Electric and water are on each support pillar, never more than three stalls away. All building surfaces are brushed concrete.
No showing out of trailers. Every horse must have a stall.

FIBERBOARD: 4'x8'x1/2" thick fiberboard is available from Quality Feed & Bedding (920/362-1040) but must be ordered two weeks in advance.

STALL PRIVACY PANEL – \$5.00 RENTAL: Stall privacy panels are sized to cover the upper portion of stalls. The lightweight panels are fitted with pre-drilled holes at each corner for easy do-it-yourself installation with your own zip-ties. AEG staff will remove panels after show. Reserve panels ahead on entry blank. Only 100 panels available.

USEF MEMBERSHIP: **Life, Senior active and Junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at regular member competitions. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer upon payment of a \$30.00 Show Pass (non-member) fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk/trot (exception: Friesian performance FR218) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) opportunity classes. Whether member or non-member, all amateurs must possess an Amateur Card issued by USEF. Back numbers will not be released until entry blank has all signatures and all required credentials have been verified by show office.**

ALL HORSES: Horses coming into Wisconsin must have a Health Certificate and negative Coggins for Equine Infectious Anemia within the prior 12 months, and proof of Rhinopneumonitis (Rhino/flu) vaccination within 6 months of entering stables. See USEF rule: GR845 for complete rule.

“JACKPOT” STAKES: Open to all; no prior qualification required to enter Jackpot class.

STAKE/CHAMPIONSHIP ELIGIBILITY: For regular Stake and Championship classes horse/pony must be entered, shown and judged in class in same section. To qualify for Amateur, Ladies, Adult or Junior Exhibitor Stake/Championship, horse/pony must have been shown in a class in the same section by an amateur, lady or junior exhibitor.

“DENVER JUNIOR HORSE” CLASS: For horses five years and under. It originated at the Denver National Western Stock Show, annually held in January, and is most appropriate for use at shows held early in the year, such as Spring Fling.

ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED

RING SIZES, FOOTING: Show ring is 100' x 220', warm-up is 100' x 200', with 55' connecting chute. Footing is shavings on dirt.

HOLD HARMLESS STATEMENT: Any and all entries in this horse show shall be conditioned upon the following terms and conditions: The Mid-America Spring Fling Horse Show, Mid-America Horse Show Association, Alliant Energy Center, show management and sponsors will be in no case responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold them blameless for any loss or injury which may occur by fire, theft or otherwise.

MID-AMERICA MEMBERS ONLY: Exhibitors (defined as owners, riders and trainers in performance classes; riders and instructors only in equitation and academy classes) must be current members of Mid-America Horse Show Association. Membership dues are: \$30 Junior (17 yrs. & under); \$25 Academy Rider (any age); \$35 Senior (18 yrs. & over); \$50 Family; \$60 Business. Membership applications are on the website and available at show office.

DISPLAY SPACE: Vendors welcomed; call Stephanie Peterson 612-708-9753 for details about display space.
