OPEN FIVE-GAITED

Callaway's Ethel became a dominating force in 2022 in what was her first full season in the five-gaited ranks. The Callaway's Blue Norther sired mare rose to the top of the open five-gaited High Point Report with 138 points. Richmond DeHart represented Stonehedge Saddlebreds LLC aboard Ethel throughout the season, beginning with her Open Five-Gaited victory pass at Madison Classic. The entry also made victory passes in the gaited ranks at ASAW Summerfun and Mane Event and collected the reserve honors at Midwest Charity and All American Horse Classic. Callaway's Ethel closed out her show season with the fourth place prize in the Five-Gaited Mares offering at the UPHA/American Royal and the sixth place finish in the Five-Gaited National Championship.

A total of 108 points landed Cash For Keeps into the reserve spot on the open five-gaited leaderboard. Karen Longo's son of El Dorado's Stonewall Jackson was presented by a trio of riders in 2022 beginning with Luman Wadhams who directed Cash For Keeps to the Open Five-Gaited blue ribbon at UPHA Chapter 14 Spring Premiere. The competitor additionally swept the open five-gaited division at Jersey Classic, UPHA Chapter 14 Summer Classic, Eastern States Exposition, and Twin State Octoberfest with both Erin McCracken and Camryn McHugh and garnered reserve honors at Syracuse International and ASHAV.

LADIES FIVE-GAITED

Deputy's Heir's busy and successful 2022 season landed this entry in the top spot on the ladies five-gaited rankings with 179 points. Janelle D'Amato and Karen Comer teamed up with this Roseridge Deputy sired entry at 10 horse shows. Deputy's Heir swept the ladies five-gaited ranks at Blowing Rock, Capital City Classic, Southeastern Charity, Dallas Fall Classic, and Clemson Fall Classic. He garnered additional victory passes and reserve finishes from Lexington Junior League, ETSA Midsummer Classic, North Carolina State Championship, and the Alabama Charity Championship. With D'Amato in the saddle, Deputy's Heir also succeeded on the green shavings of Freedom Hall with the seventh place prize in the Ladies Five-Gaited Geldings class.

Keen Behringer represented Silver Brook Stables Inc. with Share The Moment, the reserve finisher on the ladies High Point Report. The athletic He's Born To Royalty sired mare secured 137 points and made ladies five-gaited victory passes at Blue Ridge and ASHAV. She picked up impressive ribbons from Asheville Saddlebred Classic and added a world's title to her resume as the Ladies Five-Gaited Mares Reserve World's Champion. Share The Moment finished her season with the reserve ribbon in the Ladies Five-Gaited Mares class from the UPHA/American Royal as well as the fourth place prize in the Ladies Five-Gaited National Championship.

AMATEUR FIVE-GAITED

Cloverleaf Tahari led the way on the amateur fivegaited leaderboard with 211 accrued points. Denise Feldman had the riding assignments aboard her Red Hawk Red Hawk sired mare who succeeded under the Wingswept banner. Tahari and Feldman scored impressive ribbons from Asheville Saddlebred Classic, Rock Creek, and the All American Horse Classic. They were crowned the Ladies Amateur Five-Gaited Reserve Grand Champions at Blue Ridge and made the victory pass as the Amateur Five-Gaited Stake winners at the Kentucky Fall Classic. This duo contended against the world's best to secure the third place prize in the Amateur Five-Gaited Mares offering in Louisville as well as the sixth place ribbon in the Ladies Amateur Five-Gaited Mares class. Their season concluded at the UPHA/American Royal where they topped the Amateur Five-Gaited Mares qualifier en route to the third place honors in the Amateur Five-Gaited National Stake in their final show ring appearance together. Lauren Miller will campaign Cloverleaf Tahari in 2023 in the junior exhibitor ranks.

Little Rocketman was sent into the reserve spot on the amateur High Point Report with 201 accrued points from nine horse shows. Mike McIntosh directed Jill O'Hara and the son of Desert's Supreme Memories to amateur five-gaited victory passes at Blue Ribbon Springtime Classic, River Ridge, and Spooktacular Horse Show. This pair swept the gaited ranks at Heartland Classic, Dayton, and ASHAM Charity Fall and claimed the amateur reserve streamers at both Shelby County Fair and All American Horse Classic. One of their most memorable showings came at the Lexington Junior League, where O'Hara and Rocketman left the ring as the Ladies Amateur Five-Gaited Reserve Grand Champions.

JUNIOR EXHIBITOR FIVE-GAITED 17 AND UNDER

Sophia Anderson closed out her junior exhibitor career aboard Riverdreams' Spitfire at the top of the junior exhibitor 17 and under five-gaited leaderboard with 233 points. Under the direction of the High Caliber team, Anderson and her Marc Of Charm sired chestnut had a remarkable season highlighted by their success at Lexington Junior League, Kentucky State Fair, and UPHA/American Royal. They were Lexington's Junior Exhibitor Five-Gaited Reserve Grand Champions, Louisville's Junior Exhibitor Five-Gaited 14-17 Reserve World's Champion of Champions, and Kansas City's Junior Exhibitor Five-Gaited 14-17 National Champions. This pair also swept the fivegaited ranks at ASHAV and earned additional High Point Report points from Midwest Charity, Asheville Saddlebred Classic, and J.D. Massey.

Soquili's The Big Easy and Kaley Gassen continued their five-gaited domination with the reserve finish on the High Point Report. This was yet another gaited competitor trained by Debbie Foley to land on the leaderboard. The son of Santana's Awari scored 214 points from five horse shows, guided by Gassen. Together they swept the five-gaited 13 and under division at Asheville Saddlebred Classic and Midwest Charity and collected additional impressive ribbons from Blue Ridge. Some of their greatest season achievements came in Louisville as the Junior Exhibitor Five-Gaited 13 and Under World's Champion of Champions and the 13 and under section two world's champions. The capped the year at the UPHA/American Royal as the Junior Exhibitor Five-Gaited 13 and Under National Champions after also topping the 13 and under qualifier.



With Shiflet in the saddle, Lexingtonian was the Junior Five-Gaited winner at J.D. Massey, Asheville Saddlebred

Classic, and Shenandoah. He additionally succeeded at the highest level as the Bill Wise ASHBA Sweepstakes Four-Year-Old Five-Gaited World's Champion and the Junior Five-Gaited World's Champion of Champions.

Natalie Jane's first full season in the show ring resulted in the reserve spot on the junior five-gaited High Point Report with 97 points. Golden Creek Farms is the proud owner of this daughter of Top Of The Mark, who was presented by both Tre and Emily Lee. Natalie Jane was the Junior Five-Gaited winner at Midwest Charity and the Junior Five-Gaited Mares victor at Lexington Junior League. She garnered additional accolades on the green shavings as the Junior Five-Gaited Mares World's Champion and the Junior Five-Gaited World's Champion of Champions.

Fox Grape's Flashpoint enjoyed a triumphant debut season, culminating with 75 points and the top spot on the three & under five-gaited leaderboard. The Samur sired mare represented owner and breeder Dr. Owen Weaver with trainer Steve Wheeler in the saddle. Flashpoint made her first show ring appearance with the yellow ribbon in the UPHA Five-Gaited Classic at Rock Creek. She then scored the reserve honors in the Three-Year-Old Five-Gaited class at Shelbyville. The young mare next excelled in Louisville as the ASHBA National Futurity Three-Year-Old Five-Gaited World's Champion before capping her season as the UPHA Five-Gaited Classic Grand Champion in Kansas City.

SH Lynn's Prize finished the season with 66 points in the reserve position on the High Point Report. The young Carl Lynn sired mare entered the 2022 with a world's title to her name already from 2021. Bret Day had the riding assignments of Sally Groub Gayeski's mare, who was the UPHA Five-Gaited Classic red ribbon winner at Asheville Saddlebred Classic and claimed the reserve honors during Ocala's Three-Year-Old Five-Gaited class. Lynn's Prize also secured the fifth place away at Blue Ridge in the UPHA Five-Gaited Classic and in Louisville's Three-Year-Old Five-Gaited Mares offering.





This time it was CH Macho Camacho who topped the five-gaited pony ranks for the second consecutive year. Lauren Miller piloted this game competitor to a total of 208 points from six horse shows. They swept the five-gaited pony ranks at Asheville Saddlebred Classic, Shenandoah, and Ocala and earned additional tricolors and reserve honors from J.D. Massey and North Carolina State Championship. CH Macho Camacho added to his impressive show ring record with Miller as the Five-Gaited Pony World's Champion of Champions and qualifier world's champions.

Michele Ziegler and Leatherwood's Rita Bonita finished their first season together in the reserve position on the five-gaited pony leaderboard with 190 points. Under the direction of Quintus VanderSpuy, this Leatherwood's Starlight sired mare made five-gaited pony victory passes at ASAC and Raleigh Spring Premier. Her season also included top prizes from Asheville Saddlebred Classic, Shenandoah, Lexington Junior League, and Ocala. However, their most memorable achievement came in Louisville as the Five-Gaited Pony Reserve World's Champion of Champions.



Stonecroft Spotlight starred in the spotlight at the top of the open three-gaited High Point Report with 195 points. Barbara Goodman Manilow was the proud owner of this son of I'm First who excelled under the direction of Clark Clouse. Together, Clouse and Spotlight made open three-gaited victory passes at ASAC, Southern Saddlebred Spring Fling, Cleveland Tri-State Charity, Dayton, and ASHAV, with reserve honors earned at Indiana Spring Classic. Stonecroft Spotlight also succeeded on the highest levels of the Saddlebred industry. He secured the tricolor as the Three-Gaited Grand Champion at the Lexington Junior League and was crowned the Three-Gaited 15.2 and Under Reserve World's Champion in Louisville. He ended his season in victorious fashion as the Three-Gaited National Champion at the UPHA/American Royal.

The Crowd Went Nuts has been heralded as one of the breed's best walk/trot competitors. Sired by Undulata's Nutcracker, Diane Sembler Kamins' entry netted 140 points under the direction of both the Visser Stables team as well as Steve and Tiffany Wheeler. Amateur rider Erin Eichenbaum excelled in the open division aboard this entry beginning with their sweeps of the open three-gaited ranks at both J.D. Massey and Asheville Saddlebred Classic. The Crowd Went Nuts then repeated his 2021 achievements as the Three-Gaited Over 15.2 World's Champion and the Three-Gaited World's Grand Champion. Eichenbaum and The Crowd Went Nuts made their last appearance of the year at the UPHA/American Royal as the Three-Gaited Over 15.2 victors.

Lady Elegance and Barbara Goodman Manilow left the show ring for the final time in 2022 as the Ladies Three-Gaited Reserve National Champions after they also topped the Ladies Three-Gaited Over 15.2 class at the UPHA/ American Royal.

Tango's Token Kiss celebrated his last season in the show ring with an undefeated record. Grace Arnold's son of Tango's Parting Kiss scored 110 points in the reserve spot on the ladies three-gaited High Point Report. With Alexandra Lilly in the saddle, this pair represented the Mercer Springs banner with the Ladies Three-Gaited win at Bonnie Blue. They then swept the ladies three-gaited ranks at Shenandoah. With Kristen Olson in the saddle, this pair swept the amateur three-gaited ranks at FASH Spring, Wisconsin Futurity, and Mane Event and earned two ladies amateur wins at Midwest.

They additionally made a victory pass as the ASAW Summerfun Amateur Three-Gaited Stake winners as they journeyed to the UPHA/American Royal. CH On Higher Ground ended his 2022 campaign in victorious fashion as the Ladies Amateur Three-Gaited National Champion.

CH Don't Mention It was yet another exhibitor that garnered a nearly unblemished record in 2022. Susan Swope was the primary rider aboard her Don't Tell Em' Jack sired partner, under the direction of the Peter and Kim Cowart. Together, Swope and Don't Mention It netted 196 points from five horse shows to secure the reserve position on the amateur leaderboard. Susan Swope and CH Don't Mention It were the Amateur Three-Gaited Grand Champions at Gasparilla Charity, Asheville Saddlebred Classic, and Shenandoah, with an additional amateur victory pass made at Ocala. Their most impressive accomplishments came in Louisville where this pair was named the Amateur Three-Gaited World's Champion of Champions as well as the Amateur Three-Gaited 15.2 and Under World's Champions.

Jones and the Undulata's Nutcracker sired CH Katharine The Great made a total of eight junior exhibitor victory passes at ASAC, J.D. Massey, Asheville Saddlebred Classic, Midwest Charity and ASHAV. This pair made a stop at Lexington Junior League en route to Louisville to be named the Junior Exhibitor Three-Gaited 14-17 Reserve Grand Champions. They then took on the breed's best on the green shavings, as the Junior Exhibitor Three-Gaited 14-17 World's Champion of Champions and the 14-17 section two world's champions. CH Katharine The Great once again carried Aida Jones down victory lane, this time at the UPHA/American Royal-their final show of 2022. They swept the junior exhibitor threegaited 14-17 division including being named the 14-17 national champions.

Stella Rintoul and First Class Lady made trainers Chris and Stephanie Brannan proud as they finished the 2022 show season in the reserve position on the junior exhibitor leaderboard with 202 points. Rintoul and her I'm First sired mare were crowned the junior exhibitor reserve grand champions at Asheville Saddlebred Classic, Shelby County Fair, Blue Ridge, and ASHAV, with additional top ribbons earned at J.D. Massey. They left Louisville with a world's title to their name as the Junior Exhibitor Three-Gaited 13 and Under Section One Reserve World's Champions en route to the fourth place honors in the 13 and under championship. This duo saved their best performances for last with the sweep of the 13 and under division at UPHA/American Royal. Their final show ring appearance together came with the tricolor as the Junior Exhibitor Three-Gaited 13 and Under National Champions.

ings in Louisville and finished his year with the third place prize in Kansas City's Country Hunter Pleasure National Championship.




