Rules and Regulations

PAYMENT: No entries will be accepted unless fees are paid or an open check is presented. **Stalls cannot be reserved unless accompanied by payment in full for stalls.**

All Accounts MUST be settled before Sunday October 17, 2010. Open checks will be accepted for processing.

2. REFUNDS: In case of horses being entered and not exhibited, the stall fees are not refundable after the closing date. Any request to withdraw horses after the closing date and prior to Wednesday, October 13, 2010 must be supported with a veterinarian certificate giving complete diagnosis. Entry fees may be refunded or credited only on receipt of such veterinary certificate.

ENTRIES: Entries close October 1, 2010, The word "entry" will not be accepted. Each entry blank must be filled in completely and properly signed before numbers will be issued. A separate Academy Entry Form must be used for academy entries. **There is a \$10.00 office fee per horse.** Return entries to: P.O. Box 1087, Hartselle, AL 35640.

4. POST ENTRIES: Post entries will be accepted up to 24 hours prior to each performance without post entry fee. However, entries will be accepted up to two hours before show time with a post entry fee of \$10 per entry. In event of an emergency (less than two hours), post entries will be accepted at an emergency fee of \$30.

5. SCRATCHES: All scratches must be made two hours prior to show time.

6. HORSE SHOW OFFICE: The horse show office will close two hours prior to each scheduled starting time of each evening performance for taking entries for that performance. Thursday, Friday and Saturday morning post entries can be made up to 1 hour before show time. Any scratches after these times will be accepted but entry fees will be retained.

7. STABLING: Stalls will be available from Monday, October 11 through Sunday, October 17 @ \$85 per stall and does not include first bedding. **Stalls will not be reserved unless accompanied by payment of stall fees.** A limited number of front porches are available for \$30. An additional \$10/day per stall will be charged for horses arriving prior to Monday, October 11, 2010 payable to Morgan County Celebration Arena.

8. GROUNDS FEE: A grounds fee of \$20 per day per animal will be assessed for all animals not paying a stall fee.

9. DAMAGES: All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to barns or other properties on the show grounds and will be charged accordingly.

10. RING PROCEDURE: The gate to the show ring will be closed two minutes after the first horse enters the ring. Any exhibitor not in the ring by that time will not be admitted. Please cooperate by being on time. Rider conflicts shall be worked out with the Paddock Master. Due to unforeseen problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls over that system must be considered a courtesy. Therefore, no protest will be upheld, nor will any section be changed, on the basis of PA malfunction.

11. DISCIPLINE: Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judges or officials on the part of the owner, manager, rider, driver or attendant shall be grounds to disqualify the horse. The owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees. In the case of any horse being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in that class shall take the prize that has been awarded to such disqualified horse.

12. SHOW COMMITTEE: Should any questions arise that are not provided for in the foregoing rules, the same shall be referred to the show committee whose decision will be final. The show committee reserves the right to decline to receive any entry and to return any entry fee and/or stable fee before or during the show, without being liable for compensation. Every class offered herein will be conducted in the spirit of USEF rules and judged in accordance therewith. The show manager/committee will act as steward when any rule needs to be reviewed for clarification. Due to time constraints Grand Championship classes will not be stripped.

13. CLASSES: The show committee reserves the right to limit entries, change, cancel, limit, or combine classes at its discretion to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries, without claim for damages. **Academy classes will split at 12. Ten and under classes will split at 12. Driving classes will split at 15 and all other classes will split at 25.**

14. CLASS DESCRIPTIONS: The following descriptions are used for this horse show. **Stake classes:** Only opportunity to show in a particular division, no championship is offered (primarily young horse classes). **Championship:** Final competition for a particular division that requires a qualifier, but will not be stripped. **Grand Championship:** Final competition for a particular division. Will not be stripped.

15. SHOW RING: No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitor and those having official or requested duties to perform. No horse will be allowed in the show ring except at such hours as posted at the show office or announced on the PA system by the Celebration Arena Management.

16. LIABILITY: The show committee, Celebration Arena, Morgan County Junior League, and/or any sponsor shall not be responsible for any accident that may occur to any owner, driver, rider, trainer, attendant, spectator, animal, and/or equipment at the show.

17. EXHIBITORS: Passes will be issued when numbers are picked up at the horse show office. Two car passes per horse.

18. PROPER ATTIRE: All riders, drivers, and attendants must be neatly and appropriately dressed when entering the ring.

19. PETS: Pets must remain on a leash at all times and are the owner's responsibility.

20. NEGATIVE COGGINS: A valid negative Coggins test within one year of show must accompany each horse and be available for inspection by Alabama inspectors at the show grounds.

21. PRIZE MONIES: Premiums will be paid by check and mailed to the address of record by December 1. **If you have not received your prize money by 1/1/2011 please contact: Janet Byron, 256-773-4594. Any checks not cashed by the last day of January, 2010 will be forfeited to the show.**

22. PARKING: All trucks, vans, trailers, and RVs after unloading must park in the designated parking areas.

23. CAMPERS: Camper hookups are available through The Morgan County Celebration Arena with payment to the facility upon arrival at the arena. **Call 256 584-6725.**

24. RETURNED CHECKS: All checks returned for insufficient funds will be charged a \$50 handling fee. No one will be allowed to enter if they have a bad check, handling fee or unpaid account.

25. CHALLENGE AND MEMORIAL TROPHIES: The trophies will be presented to the winners of specific classes but will remain with The Alabama Charity Championship Horse Show.

26. BEDDING: Bedding will be available through the offices of the Celebration Arena with payment to Celebration Arena @ \$7 per bag. For pre-ordered bedding, please complete & return the bedding card enclosed with a check for the total amount or open check. **Bedding fees must not be included with stalls and entry fees.**

27. FEED & HAY: **Feed and hay are not available** on the show grounds. Local vendors will supply product lines & address/maps will be in the horse show office if needed.

AMERICAN SADDLEBRED DIVISION

Horses to be shown in Five Gaited, Three Gaited, Fine Harness and American Saddlebred Pleasure Horse sections must be registered with the American Saddlebred Registry or the Canadian Livestock Records Corporation. All horses must be serviceably sound. Horses shall be shown without artificial appliances (e.g., wired ears). Inconspicuously applied hair in mane or tail, a tail brace and mouth controls are permitted. In the event a horse has lost the sight in one eye, it must appear to have vision and may be shown with an artificial eye or contact lens. Quarter boots are permitted in the Five Gaited and Fine Harness classes. All horses will be worked both ways of the ring at all required gaits as directed by the judge. **Due to time constraints Grand Championship Classes will not be stripped.**

FIVE GAITED

The Five-Gaited Saddlebred should possess beauty, brilliance, elegance and refinement but its energy should be directed toward speed in an animated form. Entries shall be shown with a full mane and tail. Gait requirements are animated walk, trot, slow gait, rack and canter.

Permissible as plain shod shall be a shoe (inclusive of caulks), which may be thicker at the heel and may include toe clips and side clips. Also permissible is an eggbar shoe. Not permissible as plain shod: bands, bars, pads of any kind, wedges, lead, springs, any attachment that extends below the bottom of the shoe, and any foreign substance not specified as permissible. The sole and entire frog of the foot must be visible. Any animal with prohibited shoeing must be disqualified from further competition at that competition and forfeit all entry fees and winnings. Entries must be shown with full mane and tail. Tails must not be gingered or put in any device (i.e., tailset, bustle or brace) which alters their carriage while on the grounds. The fact that a horse's tail has once been set does not exclude participation. Braids and artificial manes are prohibited. Inconspicuously applied hair in the tail is permitted. Classes are open only to mares and/or geldings. Horses are to be shown by an Amateur or by a Junior Exhibitor. Qualifying gaits in under saddle classes are flat walk, trot, extended trot and canter. In Driving classes, the gaits are a flat walk, trot and extended trot. Manners and suitability as a pleasure mount are paramount. Transitions from one gait to another should be smooth and effortless. ROADSTER DIVISION

There are two types of Roadsters for competition: those suitable for bike and those suitable for road wagon. Occasionally there are horses or ponies that are suitable for both purposes. Usually the Wagon Roadster will have more scale and height than the Bike Roadster. Roadsters in the Wagon sections must have the strength to comfortably pull a wagon without losing form. Typical Roadsters in the Wagon sections are good looking horses or ponies that compliment the appointments of the wagons. Roadsters in the Bike sections are able to strongly perform three distinct speeds at the trot and have the look of a refined race horse or pony. Judges must emphasize that roadsters are to be shown at three distinct speeds. Exhibitors executing gaits not called for must be penalized. Horses and ponies must be serviceably sound and shown without artificial appliances (e.g., wired ears, chains, shackles, draw reins, kicking strap, conspicuous wire cavessons) except boots and inconspicuously applied tail switch or brace. The principal gait assignment for Roadsters is the trot. They shall be asked to trot at three different speeds: the jog-trot, the road gait and then at full speed. At all speeds they should work in form. Pacey gaited or mixey gaited horses that pace and rack the turns or break and run on the turns shall be penalized. Classes for Roadster Ponies to Bike are restricted to ponies 52" and under. In Under Saddle classes entries may not exceed 54". In Bike and Under Saddle classes the driver is to wear stable colors, cap and jackets to match. In Road Wagon classes exhibitors shall wear a business suit with a hat of choice. The exhibitor's number must be worn on the back of the driver. All Junior Exhibitors must wear properly fitting protective headgear which passes or surpasses ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and the harness must be secured and properly fitted.

UPHA CLASSICS

The UPHA Classics may be offered for Three-Year-Olds and under for the American Saddlebred as well as for Four-Year Olds and under for the Ponies.

In order to show, horses or ponies must be registered with the appropriate breed association and must be shown under their registered name.

The professional trainer of UPHA classic entries must be an active member of UPHA in good standing and their membership number must appear on the entry blank. Two hundred Fifty dollars (\$250) is added per horse division and (\$250) pony division by Alabama Charity Championship Horse Show/Sponsor. All monies collected in each Classic will be disbursed in that class. Prize money is divided as follows: \$150 is deducted from the total with \$50 going to fourth, fifth and sixth places. Of the balance, 50% is paid for first place, 30% to second place, and 20% to third place. If there are only two entries, the total prize money will be split 60% to first place and 40% to second. If only three entries show, the original percentage applies without the \$300 deduction for these two possibilities. In case of only one entry, the entry would receive 100% of the total. Prize money will be distributed as soon as possible, but no later than 30 days after the conclusion of the Classic.

RULES FOR ENTERING UPHA CLASSICS

A non-refundable ***ELIGIBILITY FEE*** of \$50 shall be paid to the UPHA office postmarked on or before April 1 of each year. After April 1st, the Eligibility Fee becomes \$100 per horse. Payment of the eligibility fee will be made in the name of the entered horse and shall make that animal eligible for all Classic classes held that year. Eligibility remains with the horse throughout the year and should transfer of ownership occur. Eligibility Fees collected will be used as added prize money for the UPHA Classic Grand Championships. All Eligibility Fees Collected within a breed will be used in that Breed's Championship Classes.

The entry fee for each qualifying class is \$100 and is made in two payments. The first payment, the ***Declaration Fee***, is \$50 and must be made by the entry closing date of the particular horse show (October 1, 2010). The second payment, the ***Starting Fee***, is also \$50 and is due 24 hours prior to the class, whenever practical. All entry fees, or partial entry fees, are added to the total purse of the class.
