

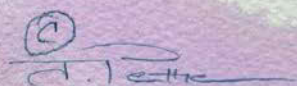

ABOUT THE FACILITY



The Tennessee Miller Coliseum is a 22+ million dollar facility that is located just 30 minutes South of Nashville. Sitting on a 154 acres, the 222,000 square foot complex boasts a state-of-the-art, climate controlled 150' x 300' main arena with an attached 120' x 200' warm-up arena, as well as a large outdoor ring. Exhibitors have access to an additional indoor arena for warm up during the evening performances, totaling 3 warm up areas. The stabling areas have recently been blacktopped and feature 500 10' x 10' stalls with accessible power and water, wash racks, manure bins, shoeing area, restrooms with showers, and a covered walkway from the main barn to the arena. 117 camper hookups are available with power and water for \$35/night.

Requests for Early Arrivals must be made in advance and may be stabled outside the main barn. Early arrivals \$15/day/stall.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **PAYMENT:** No entries will be accepted and no stalls reserved unless accompanied by payment in full of stall and entry fees. An open check is acceptable. Non-Stalled horses will be charged a \$25/day grounds fee.
2. **REFUNDS:** In case of horses being entered and not exhibited, the stall fees are NOT REFUNDABLE after closing date unless they can be rented to someone else. Entry fees will be refunded if a veterinary certificate is provided.
3. **ENTRIES:** Closing date for entries is April 16, 2018. The word "Entry" will not be accepted. Each entry blank must contain the name and full description of each horse or pony and the class in which it is to be entered. Any entries not paid in full or received after the closing date, except stake and championship classes, will be considered Post Entries. *Post Entries will be accepted at a \$10.00 additional charge per class.*
4. **POST ENTRIES:** Post entries will be accepted as follows: Thursday, Friday, and Saturday evening classes during regular office hours. Emergency Post Entries will be accepted in the Paddock at a \$25.00 additional charge per class.
5. **SCRATCHES:** All scratches must be made 2 hours prior to show time.
6. **DAMAGES:** All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to barns or other properties on the showgrounds, and will be charged accordingly.
7. **STALLS:** Stalls will be available from Tuesday, April 24th at 8:00am through Sunday, April 29th at Noon, at \$110.00 per stall. No stalls will be reserved unless accompanied by entries and payment in full for both stalls and entries. An open check is acceptable. There are 500 permanent stalls available and will be assigned on a first-come, first-serve basis with consideration given to previous attendance and sponsorship. Temporary stabling may also be used if necessary. No initial bedding will be supplied. Stable assignments are at the discretion of show management. Requests for specific stalls will be considered but not guaranteed. **Stall fees are non-refundable after the closing date of entries unless they can be rented to someone else.**
8. **BEDDING:** Bedding will be available at \$7.50/bag through the TMC and ordered in the show office. Bedding will be pre-delivered if ordered in advance on the entry form. **NO OUTSIDE BEDDING DELIVERIES ALLOWED**, but you may haul in your own.
9. **HOLDS:** Holds must be requested at least one (1) hour in advance of each session. Holds will be limited to five (5) minutes. Emergency holds will be accepted by the Paddock Master.
10. **RULES:** Every class offered herein will be conducted in the spirit of USEF rules and judged in accordance therewith. The show manager and chairmen will act as steward when any rule needs to be reviewed for clarification.
11. **HORSES:** All horses must be serviceably sound. In case of suspected unsoundness, the judge may, if he so desires, have the horse examined by the show veterinarian, and his

decision will be final. No Exhibitor may use a Veterinarian's Statement to contradict the judge's decision.

12. CAVEATS: The Show Management reserves the right to decline to receive any entry and to return any entry fee and/or stable fee before or during the show, without being liable for compensation. Three entries are necessary to fill a class unless otherwise specified, or the class may be declared void, at the option of the Committee. If the entries in two or more classes of the same division are not sufficient to fill, the committee reserves the right to combine the same into competition.

13. LIABILITY: Neither Southern Saddlebred Sales Inc., the Show Chairmen, Show Manager, the Tennessee Miller Coliseum, nor any volunteer or sponsor will be responsible for any accident which may occur to any owner, rider, driver, groom, attendant, animal, or equipment at the show. ***Each rider exhibits at their own risk.***

WARNING: Under Tennessee Law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or death of a participant in equine activities, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated Title 44, Ch. 20, Part 1.

14. SHOW RING: No person will be allowed in the show ring during the time of judging except the exhibitors and those having official or requested duties to perform. No horse will be allowed in the show ring except at such hours as posted in the show office.

15. DISCIPLINE: Exhibitors are notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the judge or officials, on the part of the owner, manager, rider, driver, or groom shall be grounds to disqualify the horse, and the owner shall forfeit his entry fee and other fees. In the case of any horse being disqualified, the winner of the next succeeding prize in that class shall take the prize that had been awarded to such disqualified horse.

16. DISPUTES: Should any question arise that is not provided for in these rules, the same shall be referred to the Show Manager/Chairmen whose decision shall be final.

17. DRESS: All riders, drivers, attendants, and grooms shall be neatly and appropriately dressed upon entering the ring.

18. PETS: Pets must remain on leash at all times and are the owner's responsibility.

19. NEGATIVE COGGINS: A valid negative Coggins test within one year of the show must accompany each horse and must be available for inspection.

20. PARKING: All trucks, vans, trailers, and RVs, after unloading, must park in the designated parking area.

21. CHECKS: All checks should be made payable to Southern Saddlebred. Returned checks will incur a \$50.00 handling fee. No one will be allowed to show who has a bad check or handling fee outstanding.

22. RING PROCEDURES: The gate to the show ring will remain open two minutes after the first horse enters the ring, after which the gate will be closed. Any exhibitor not in the ring by that time will not be admitted. Please cooperate by being on time. Due to unforeseeable problems with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls over that system must be considered a courtesy. Therefore, no protest will be upheld, nor will any section be changed due to a PA malfunction.

23. CAMPERS: 117 Camper hookups are available for \$35.00 per night and paid for in the show office.

24. GOLF CARTS: Golf carts are to be operated only by a licensed driver.

25. STABLE AREA: Gas, electric or propane heaters, propane tanks and hot plates are prohibited in the stable area. All electrical extension cords must be 12 gauge, 3 wire and prong negative type.

26. NO SMOKING IN ANY BUILDING, RESTROOM OR STABLE ON GROUNDS!

Academy Division Guidelines

The Academy Division is for entry-level riders who are taking lessons and in their first years of competition.

Horses are not to be judged and must be lesson-type horses used regularly in a lesson program and must display the characteristics of such. Horses may be privately owned, but must not be in training. They may cross enter into any other pleasure or equitation division with a different rider. They may be flat shod or have one pad and/or wedge if necessary for therapeutic reasons or for the comfort of the horse. No excessive show packages. No braids. Hoof blacking is optional.

Riders are judged on their ability to control and show the horse to the best advantage. **Academy Equitation** classes are judged on basic Equitation skills with correct diagonals and leads. Riders should convey impression of effective and easy control. **Academy Showmanship** classes should also be judged on the rider's showmanship and general ringmanship abilities, such as command of the horse, speed, placement in ring and collectiveness. **Helmets are required for all Juvenile exhibitors.** No full riding suits allowed. Jodphurs, jodphur boots, gloves, button down shirt, vest and tie are recommended. Any rider who has shown in the regular performance division or in a full suit at any show is prohibited from returning to the Academy division. Once a rider has shown in Academy Walk/Trot/Canter classes they may not return to Academy Walk/Trot. Academy riders may not cross enter into any other performance division at the same show except driving and in-hand classes.

***Limit Horses and Limit Riders** are those entries who have not won six (6) blue ribbons in a performance class at any regular show.*
