ENTRY FORMS

Must be completed in full, signed and accompanied with full payment.

POST ENTRIES

Post entries will be accepted in all classes at one and one half times the regular entry fee. Exception: All Championship classes (at regular fee). Post entries will be accepted a session prior to the session in which the class will be held.

USEF MEMBERS STATEMENT

Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the USEF rule book and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. In situations arising which are not covered specifically by USEF rules, the following rules, or the rules specific to each show (contained in the individual sections), the decision of the show managers and/or stewards shall be final. Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule; 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-h members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes; 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing or their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

AMHA MEMBERS

Life, general, junior and junior life members are eligible to participate in all regional show classes. A non-member of the AMHA may participate as a rider, driver, handler, owner, lessee, agent or trainer at a regional show upon payment of a \$45 non-member fee. Classes for which membership is not required include Leadline. Walk Trot. Races. and Exhibitions.

ENTRIES

Every class offered herein which is not covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance with the Morgan Horse Judging Standards.

All horses entered in this show must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association, Inc., or the Canadian Morgan Horse Association or the British Morgan Horse Society and must be entered under their full registered name or if under one year of age be eligible for registration.

ENTRY BLANKS

Every exhibitor, rider, driver, handler, coach and trainer or his/her agent(s) must sign an entry blank. In the case of a rider, driver or handler is under the age of 18, his/her parent or guardian, or if not available, the trainer, must sign an entry blank on the minor's behalf.

REFUSAL OF ENTRIES

The Board of Directors of the American Morgan Horse Association forbids any legal entity or individual with outstanding debts 90 days or more to show at any AMHA Regional Show, The Grand National, or any AMHA sponsored event. All debts must be settled directly with the AMHA office, NOT with show officials. These individuals, their family members, employees and any horse owned, leased or shown by them will not be allowed to enter the show arena.

The Board of Directors of the Jubilee Regional Championship Morgan Horse Show forbids any legal entity or individual with outstanding debts from past years from showing at the 2017 Jubilee Regional Championship Morgan Horse Show. All debts must be settled directly with the Jubilee Morgan Horse Show Manager. These individuals, their family members, employees and any horse owned, leased or show by them will not be allowed to enter the show arena.

Management reserves the right to decline any entry and to return entry fees before or during the Show, without being liable for compensation. Management also reserves the right to cancel, combine or split any class.

HEALTH PAPERS

All Illinois horses more than 12 months of age are required to have a negative Coggins test for EIA within the last 12 months. All out-of-state horses more than 12 months of age must have a negative test for EIA within the past 12 months and be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection or Health Certificate issued within the past 30 days. Foals by their dam's side do not need a Coggins, however, their dam must have a valid Coggins test. The Jubilee Regional Championship Horse Show is not required to check for testing. NOTE: The State of Illinois requires that all out-of-state horses have an Entry Permit Number (See below).

ENTRY PERMIT NUMBER REQUIRED FOR EQUINE ENTERING ILLINOIS

Effective February 1, 2004, all equine entering Illinois (for any reason other than slaughter) must be accompanied by a negative test for EIA conducted within a year if the animal is more than one year of age, certificate of veterinary inspection (health certificate) issued by an accredited veterinarian within 30 days of entry, and an entry permit number issued by the Illinois Department of Agriculture. This new requirement comes on the heels of the Monkey Pox and Mad Cow reports and is part of a nationwide attempt to track the movement of livestock, including horses, throughout the country.

Entry permit numbers are available by calling the Illinois Department of Agriculture, 217-782-4944 and are issued 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Permit numbers are also available online at www.agr.state.il.us. A password to access the permit program is required and will be issued to veterinarians by calling the Illinois Department of Agriculture, Bureau of Animal Health, 217-782-4944 weekdays, 8:00am-4:30pm. The following information will be required for the entry permit number:

- Name and mailing address of the owner of the animal;
- Date of the EIA test;
- Location where the animal is going.

THERE IS NO CHARGE FOR OBTAINING AN ENTRY PERMIT NUMBER FROM THE ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.

Please note: A certificate of veterinary inspection and entry permit are not required for equine residing in Illinois full time. Illinois equine traveling out-of-state on an Illinois Certificate of veterinary inspection are not required to obtain a permit to return home. Exception: if an Illinois equine is out-of-state longer than 30 days, a certificate of veterinary inspection issued by the state where the animal was residing and an entry permit will be required, as that animal is no longer recognized as being an Illinois native animal.

For equine only: The entry permit number is good for 30 days (the life of the health certificate). It is requested that if the health certificate is used for multiple entries (i.e. county fair racing, trail rides, shows on several weekends, etc.) that all events during the 30 day period be included on the health certificate. If an event is not listed on the health certificate, the owner is asked to call the Department, provide the permit number and provide the location of the additional event(s). We recognize that this may be a hardship on those racing at the county fairs and would suggest you include on the health certificate any and all fairs that you might enter during that period of time.

In accordance with the Illinois Diseased Animals Act (510 ILCS 50/1 and the regulations pertaining thereto 8 III. Adm. Code 85), violators of the permit number requirement are guilty of a business offense and shall be fined not less than \$50 nor more than \$1000. Violators of the EIA test and certificate of veterinary inspection requirements (health certificate) are subject to a \$300 fine for the first violation, a \$600 fine for the second violation, and a \$1000 fine for the third and subsequent violations. Animal Health Investigators will check for proper permits and certification. Illinois State Police also have the authority to ask for proper documentation.

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT

By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing the entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (The "Federation") and the local rules of the Competition. I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the Competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the Competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules, I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use of assign photographs, videos, audios, cable-casts, or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the Competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the Competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise any product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocable waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State, Sec GR908.4.

OFFICE PROCEDURES

- Hours: The show office will open at 12 noon, Monday, August 28, 2017. The office will open
 one hour prior to each session and will close one hour after the conclusion of the first session and
 at the conclusion of the last class of the evening session. Office bills will be finalized and closed
 Saturday evening by 9:00pm.
- **Credentials:** All Exhibitors must present a current USEF membership card or copy thereof or Non-members must pay a \$30.00 show pass fee. Please send copy of membership card with entry or bring to Show Office in order to receive your back number.

All Exhibitors must present a current AMHA membership card or copy thereof. Members not presenting a card must sign an affidavit. Non-members must pay a \$45.00 non-member fee. Please send copy of membership card with entry or bring to Show Office in order to receive your back number.

Amateur Rule Change: All Amateur Exhibitors exhibiting in classes restricted to Amateurs must present proof of Amateur Certification issued by USEF. Only active Federation members may obtain Amateur status. Please send copy of amateur card with entry or bring to Show Office in order to receive your back number.

Any exhibitor who fails to furnish USEF or AMHA membership numbers on their entry form will automatically be charged the non-member fee.

- Accounts: Any exhibitor wishing to charge fees must establish an open check charge account and furnish a signed check. We now accept Credit Cards-Visa, Mastercard & Amex.
- Social Security Number Required: Owner's social security number is required for anyone entering Jubilee Futurity and Morgan Weanling Gala.
- **Refunds:** Call or email prior to closing date of entries, all entry and stall fees will be refunded less a \$25.00 office fee. No refunds will be made after the closing date.
- Returned Checks/Declined Credit Cards: All checks returned for non-payment or credit cards delcined will be charged a \$50.00 handling fee and must be replaced by a certified or cashier's check.
- **Scratches:** Exhibitors must notify the secretary's office of scratches a session prior to the scratch. A fee of \$25.00 may be assessed any exhibitor who fails to properly notify of any scratch.
- **Rider or Driver Changes:** Any changes in rider, driver or handler must be recorded in the secretary's office in order to insure proper ring announcements and association reports. This is the exhibitor's responsibility.
- Patterns, Workouts, Orders of Go: Patterns, workouts and orders of go will be posted and exhibitors notified. Time for order of go drawing will be posted and exhibitors notified.

AMHA FORUM

The Jubilee Horse Show will host a rules forum on Wednesday, August 30, 2017 immediately after last class of the morning session.

STABLING

- **Stalls:** Permanent and temporary stalls with doors (approx. 9'x10') in buildings are available on a first come first serve basis for \$120. One night stalls are available, first comefirst serve basis is available at \$65-per night. There will be no refunds on stalls after the deadline date unless they can be reassigned and sold. Stalls are available Monday, August 28, 2017 and must be vacated by 10:00am, Sunday, September 3, 2017. **Any exceptions must be approved in advance by the show manager. It is imperative that early arrivals contact the manager so that she can stable you in an area that is available and not occupied by the previous show. Early arrival fee is \$15.00 per horse stall per day**
- **Stabling Policy:** The Manager will assign stabling possessing knowledge of history and location on an annual basis with careful consideration for the efficient use of the total available stalls. Entries requesting to be stabled with a particular barn or trainer will not be considered unless your name appears on their stable list on their entry blank.

Exhibitors will be liable for any damage caused by them to stalls or buildings. Positively no stall changes after Thursday, August 24, 2017.

RULES PERTAINING TO SHOW

- **Parking and Campers:** Parking will NOT be permitted in front of or near barns. All vehicles must be parked in the designated areas. RV vehicles and campers must park in RV area.
- **Attire:** All riders, drivers, handlers and attendants must be appropriately attired to enter show ring. Be advised this means no jeans, no shorts, no tank or halter tops. Gentlemen attendants must wear shirt and tie for evening performances. This rule will be enforced.
- **Ring Procedure:** In classes which show collectively, two minutes will be allowed after the first horse enters the ring, at the end of two minutes the class will be closed. In classes which compete individually, failure to enter the ring within one minute after an audible signal to proceed is given, incurs elimination.
- Quiet Time for Working: There will be 90 minutes of Quiet Time in the show arena each day. The first QT will commence immediately after the completion of the morning session for 60 minutes. The second QT will commence immediately after the completion of the evening

session for 30 minutes. During this time, no popping or lash whips, or any other noise-making device will be allowed inside the arena. Exhibitors are asked to please show good judgement and consideration during Quiet Time as you are entering and exiting the ring. Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday. Quiet Times will be from 12:00-2:00pm.

- Class Splits: Management has the right to split classes at their discretion.
- Jubilee Breeders Futurity Entries: All entries must have met all requirements of the Jubilee Morgan Horse Breeders Futurity. All class entries must be made on the official entry form of the Jubilee Regional Championship Horse Show and must meet the Futurity deadline of July 15, 2017. Jubilee Futurity Performance Championships qualify for their respective Jubilee Age Group Championship.
- **UPHA Classic:** Open to three year old Morgans only, that have been nominated with UPHA. There will be \$250 added to Nomination and Starting Fees with purse divided, 1st place 50%, 2nd place 30%, 3rd place 20%, 4th place \$100, 5th place \$100, 6th place \$100. Nomination fee \$50 payable before entry closing date and \$50 payable the session prior to that in which the class is held.
- Ladies and Gentlemen Entries: Entries in Ladies and Gentlemen classes are restricted to exhibitors 18 years and over. Ladies and Gentlemen classes qualify for their respective Amateur Championship, if shown by an Amateur.
- Amateur and Junior Exhibitor Entries: Amateur classes designated "Amateur" are restricted to Amateurs 18 years and over. Junior Exhibitor classes qualify for Junior Exhibitor Championships where offered, or qualify for Amateur Championships when no Junior Exhibitor Championship is offered, however they will be judged by Amateur class specifications. Amateur, Youth, Ladies and Gentlemen classes (if shown by an amateur) qualify for Amateur Championships.
- **Open Grand Championship Entries:** To be eligible, horses must have been entered, shown and judged in one other class in that section. Exceptions: Open In-Hand Championships, first and second from age groups qualify. Equitation Championship must have been shown in an age group class, or UPHA Challenge Cup for Saddle Seat Equitation Championship.
- **Registration Certificates:** Registration certificates or photocopies thereof for each horse must be available for inspection, examination and verification by an official designated by the AMHA during the show.
- **Stripped Championship Classes:** Only Junior Horse Saddle Championships and Open Saddle Championships will be stripped.
- AMHA Medal Classes: AMHA Medal Classes will qualify for championships in their appropriate divisions.
- Dressage Deadline: Positively no Dressage entries will be accepted after midnight, August 18, 2017.
- **Dressage Times:** There will be no changes to ride time after noon on Monday, August 28, 2017.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Pet Requirement: All dogs must be kept on leash while on the show grounds. No dogs are allowed in the coliseum.
- **Golf Carts:** Golf carts are available for rent **YOU MUST PRE-ORDER ON THE ENTRY FORM**. *There will be no golf carts available to rent at the show*. The rental period is Monday-Saturday (6 days) 2 Seaters \$350.00 and 4 Seaters \$425.00

Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s)m or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operaton. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the

child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordanced with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. Refer to GR1301.7

- Camper Space: Camping fee for RVs \$25.00 per night, per camper. Camping fee for Tents \$10.00 per night, per tent. Illinois State Fairground Camper Supervisor Telephone: 217-524-9894.
- Footing: The footing in all arenas are the same and consist of a mixture of loam/sand organic matter. Indoor warmups 100'x125' & 80x125'; Outside covered show arena 150'x250"

- No lungeing in covered arena or warm up rings, lungeing area is in Livestock Center at West End of Barn 18.
- 2. Barn 14 Warm Up Ring is reserved for Dressage riders on Tuesday.

TWO-YEAR-OLD: 1. A fee of \$50 per class must be paid on or before July 15, 2017 in order to be eligible to show in the Two-Year-Old division. 2. To be eligible for nomination, a Two-Year-Old must have been nominated as a Yearling in 2015. No back entries will be accepted in 2017. 3. Applicants in this division may choose to show in Park Harness, Pleasure Driving and/or Two Year Old Mares In Hand or Two Year Old Stallions/Geldings in Hand. Class numbers must also be entered on the Jubilee Horse Show entry form, although fees are to be paid with the Futurity nomination form, not the Show Entry form.

PRIZE FUND: The value of the Futurity's Prize Fund will be the total of the Nomination Fees paid in that year, with added Donations and Fund Raising Proceeds, less Operating Expenses and Promotion/Advertising. Each year, the cost of specific awards will be deducted from the Futurity's Prize Fund and all remaining monies will be paid out as Prize Money.

MORGAN WEANLING GALA RULES & PROCEDURES THE CLASS OF 2017

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The class is open to all offspring of 2017 nominated stallions provided the stallion owners have fulfilled their financial obligations to the Morgan Weanling Gala.

Stallion Nominations as of March 31, 2017:

ASTRONOMICALLEE, BKC VALIANT STAR, CBMF HITTING THE STREETS GCH, CEDARCREST VALENTINO, CINGATE REVELATION, DELIRIUM, GRAYCLIFF TONY GCH, LEONARDO'S CRY CH, MEM INTOXICATED, MERRIEHILL AFTER HOURS GCH, MINION MILLENNIUM, NOBLE FLAIRE, QUEEN'S GLORY DAYS, REGAL MASTERPIECE, SLB DA VINCI, SPICEOLIFE RIGHT ANSWER, THE IGNITOR, TSL STARCRAFT, TUG HILL COMMANDO

Stallion owners are encouraged to promote the stallion's Morgan Weanling Gala eligibility and inform mare owners of the class and its location.

Entry fee is \$250.00. Entries are due on or before closing date of entries for the Jubilee Regional Championship show. Post entries are accepted until 3 p.m. of the day preceding the class at additional post entry fee of \$250.00.

No entries will be accepted once the draw for order of appearance begins.

Entries must meet all requirements of the MWG and MUST be made on the official entry form of the Jubilee Regional Championship show and returned to the show secretary. No refunds of entry fees will be made without a Vet's certificate.

All owners must provide their Social Security numbers on their entries in order to receive potential prize money. Winnings will not be paid without these numbers.

JUDGING PROCEDURE

The Morgan Weanling Gala will be conducted in two rounds with three Judges officiating. Each round will be scored separately and no scores will carry over from round one to round two.

USEF rules will prevail.

FIRST ROUND

In the first round, each foal will show individually.

A random drawing will be held on the day preceding the class to determine the order of appearance of each foal. Any owner or trainer who is showing more than one entry and draws consecutive spots will be given a new draw.

After entering the ring, each foal will have up to two minutes in which to be judged. The entry shall be judged standing and then at the trot. The handler then has the remainder of the two minutes to show the entry to its best advantage. At the end of the time allotment, the entry must immediately leave the ring.

Each entry must be waiting at the in-gate for its turn. Any entry showing out of order will have 5 points per judges' card deducted from their score.

In Round One, each judge may award a numerical score from 1 to 100, 100 being the highest score.

After each entry has shown, the three judges' scores will be added together to arrive at a final Round One score for the entry.

The top ten scoring entries (eleven if there is a tie for 10th) will advance to round two. All scores from both rounds will be posted on the day following the class.

When the final entry has been judged, show officials will tabulate the scores. The top ten scoring weanlings (eleven if there is a tie for 10th place) will be asked to return for Round Two.

ROUND TWO

After a short break, the ten foals (eleven foals if there is a tie for 10th place), will be asked to return to the ring for final judging in Round Two.

These entries shall enter the ring in random order. These entries will then be judged in order of line up, both standing and at the trot.

In Round Two, one judge will be designated as the call judge and the Majority Opinion System will be used.

After all entries have been judged, the judges may ask to compare certain entries before marking and signing their cards.

The judging cards will then be tabulated and Champion through 10th place will be awarded in reverse order.

ENTRY LIST

A numerical list of entries, order of appearance, sire and dam listing, and owner/handler information will be provided to the exhibitors and spectators by the Morgan Weanling Gala.

JUDGES SELECTION

The judging selection will be determined by the Jubilee Regional Championship show. The two primary judges hired by the horse show plus a third judge hired shall officiate the Morgan Weanling Gala class.

REGISTRATION

Any entry placing 1st through 10th in the Morgan Weanling Gala class must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association. If the entry is not yet registered, it will be DNAed immediately following the class. This DNA may be used in the registration of the entry. The DNA fee and any applicable veterinary fees will be deducted from that entry's prize money. All prize money recipients will have to be DNA verified if they are not previously registered. No payout of awards can be made until all ten winners have been registered with AMHA.

NET PAYOUT

The prize money payout will be determined by the number of stallions nominated for each year's program and will be paid to the top ten winners and their sires as described below. Prize money will be awarded after all ten winners have been registered with AMHA. The total amount of prize money paid to the Top Ten placings shall be the sum of the Sire

Nomination Fees received in that year ("Payout"). The Payout is distributed among the Top Ten placings according to the fixed Percentages indicated below with a fixed amount paid to the Sire Nominator and the variable balance paid to the Weanling.

The percentage distribution is as follows:

<u>USDF Membership Benefits:</u> USDF is dedicated to education, the recognition of achievement, and promotion of dressage. For details on member benefits, including educational programs, awards, and other opportunities, refer to the *USDF Member Guide* or the USDF website at www.usdf.oro.

This competition is recognized by USDF for 2017

Membership Requirements for USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized Competitions: Owners and riders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition as a rider or owner/lessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership (RM), Participating Membership (RM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF Non-Member (NM) fee. (Note: USDF Business Members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF Business Membership.) Individuals cannot compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition with a USDF Education Membership.

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse Identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR). Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit form from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or
 dams are not actually competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions
 (e.g. all Arabian, all Friesian, or all Morgan classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, pas de deux or quadrille, are exempt from this requirement. Also
 exempt are horses ridden in leadline, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4+H members, walk-trot, academy, and opportunity classes.
- Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$75.), 5-years (\$300), or life (\$1,500). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21st birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$60). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or owner/lessee for all Adequan®/USDF Year-End Awards, Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders Championship Series Finals and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GM): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an affiliate Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and participate in the USDF Rider Awards program.

Business Membership (BM): A membership that runs December 1 through November 30 and is issued to a business or organization directly by USDF. The USDF BM (\$200) offers a wider variety of advertising benefits. BMs satisfy requirements of horse ownership only.

Education Membership (EM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. This online education only membership expires 12 months after the date joined. This membership type does NOT allow an individual to compete at a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition.

Non-Member (NM) Identification Number: For each USDF NM owner/lessee and USDF NM rider there will be a USDF NM fee of \$25 per competition that must be collected by the show secretary and submitted to USDF, along with the USDF Report of Fees document and the \$5 affidavit fee and Competition Affidavit Form if the person cannot provide a copy of their USDF NM card. Owners/lessees or riders exempt from the NM number remements are also exempt from paying the USDF NM fee. If there are multiple owners of a horse and all are NMs, only one of the owners must pay the NM fee. If the horse has at least one owner who is a current USDF PM, GM, or BM there is no NM fee assessed. Competition management will be invoiced for all applicable USDF NM fees not received with the USDF post competition paperwork, along with a report listing all USDF NMs. Competition management is then required to submit the NM fees within 30 days to the USDF. An individual with a USDF NM identification number is not eligible for any USDF membership benefits. Once a USDF NM number has been assigned, a USDF NM card can be obtained from the USDF website.

Horse Identification (HID) Number: A one-time tracking number for horses (\$25). Scores earned by a horse with an HID number will be recorded, but will NOT be counted towards Adequan® USDF Year-End Awards. A horse with an HID number is not eligible to compete in Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying or championship classes or Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders Championship Series Finals. An HID number can be upgraded to a Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) for a fee of \$70. If a horse has a USDF LHR it does not need an HID number. An HID number is a one-time fee that does not need to be renewed.

Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR): A horse with an LHR (\$95) is eligible for Adequan[®]/USDF Year-End Awards, and eligible to compete at Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders Championship Series Finals and Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional qualifying and championship classes, assuming requirements for the owner and rider are met. If a horse has an LHR it does not need an HID number. An LHR does not need to be renewed.

How to Join USDF

Applications for USDF Participating Membership (PM), Business Membership (BM), Horse Identification (HID) number, and Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR) may be found in the following locations:

- On the USDF website: www.usdf.org. You can submit the application online or download the form and fax or mail it to the USDF office.
- In the show office at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions classified by USEF as Dressage Competitions, and Regular Competitions which are
 open to all breeds.

The effective date of membership is the date the form and correct fees are received in the USDF office or, if applying at a competition, the date accepted by the competition secretary, provided the application is signed and dated by the competition secretary, member, and/or horse owner on that same day.


