MORGAN HIGH POINT REPORT

OPEN PARK SADDLE

Queen's Yankee Spirit has long been an outstanding park saddle competitor. He was the 2021 Ladies Park Saddle World Champion and this year, excelled with three different riders to claim the top spot in the Open Park Saddle High Point Report leaderboard. Isabella Vincenza Alessio's Queen's Glory Days sired entry earned a total of 112 points from 5 different horse shows. Evan Orr earned top ribbons aboard Yankee Spirit at Southern States, Midwest Charity, and Blue Ridge Classic. Isabella Vincenza Alessio then took the reins to be named the Morgan Park Saddle Open Stake Grand Champion at the North Carolina State Championship before Yankee Spirit traveled to Oklahoma City for the Morgan Grand National. With David Cater in the saddle, Queen's Yankee Spirit capped his season as the Park Saddle Reserve Grand National Champion.

Ledgefields Jagged Edge has made a name for himself in the park ranks beginning with his sensational junior horse career. He reached the pinnacle of success in the Morgan industry in 2021 as the Park Saddle World Champion and finished 2022 with a nearly unblemished record. Dr. Grace Steere's son of Get Busy netted 97 points and the reserve spot on the open park saddle leaderboard. His first outing of the season came at New England Regional where David Rand rode the stallion to sweep the open park saddle ranks, including the top honors in the Park Saddle East Coast Championship. Jagged Edge then returned to Oklahoma City where he was crowned the Park Saddle Grand National Champion en route to the reserve streamers in the Park Saddle World Championship.

LADIES PARK SADDLE

Stone Pine Charlotte began the 2022 show season with her new teammate, Elizabeth Ciccone. It was a partnership that proved successful as the Lingering Hills trained mare earned the top spot on the ladies park saddle leaderboard. The daughter of SpiceOLife Present Tense GCH earned 86 points from five classes. She was the Park Saddle Ladies victor at both Greater Boston and Connecticut Morgan and scored the reserve honors from New England Morgan. Elizabeth Ciccone and Stone Pine Charlotte closed out their first year together at the Morgan Grand National where they scored impressive third place finishes in the competitive ladies park saddle ranks.

The mother-daughter duo of Tadgy Stacy and Mallory Sciaraffa worked together to help DRF Charlemagne GCH garner 74 total points and the reserve spot on the ladies park saddle leaderboard. The multi-titled Stonecroft Byzantine sired gelding excelled in the ladies division at two horse shows and three classes. Tadgy Stacy had the riding assignment to earn a victory pass with Charlemagne at Morgan Gold Cup. She handed over the reins to her daughter, Mallory Sciaraffa, for the Park Saddle Ladies Reserve Grand National title as well as the Park Saddle Ladies Reserve World Championship honors.





AMATEUR PARK SADDLE

For the second year in a row, it was Old School Groove who rose to the top of the Amateur Park Saddle High Point Report. Tamara Moravec's RWJ Commanding Topic GCH sired entry netted a total of 163 points from 12 classes at seven horse shows. Moravec and her Miller Equestrian trained teammate made amateur park saddle victories at Carousel Charity, Diamond Jubilee, Charity Fair, Santa Barbara National, and Jingle Bell. They earned the reserve honors at Morgan Medallion and then journeyed to Oklahoma City. While there, Old School Groove teamed up with Moravec to score a multitude of top ribbons in both the amateur and amateur masters divisions for 75 points.

SLLC Ironman GCH finished just a mere three points behind Old School Groove to claim the reserve spot on the amateur leaderboard. This was yet another David Rand trained park horse to excel throughout the 2022 show season. The son of HVK Man About Town finished the season with 160 points after his showings with Jane Bowers in the saddle. Together, Bowers and Ironman earned amateur park rounds of honor from UPHA Chapter 14 Spring Premiere, Connecticut Morgan, Summer Kick Off, and Massachusetts Morgan. SLLC Ironman GCH was the Park Saddle Amateur red ribbon recipient at the New England Morgan Horse Show and continued that success at the Morgan Grand National. This pair concluded their year by accumulating points as the Park Saddle Amateur Masters Grand National Champions and the Park Saddle Amateur Masters Reserve World Champions.

JUNIOR EXHIBITOR PARK SADDLE

Valley Acres Just N Time was still eligible for junior horse competition in 2022. The talented four-year-old triumphed in the junior exhibitor ranks with Claire Kiley, garnering 106 points at the top of the junior exhibitor park saddle leaderboard. Bert Earehart trained this son of SpiceOLife Present Tense GCH, who earned top junior exhibitor honors from three horse shows. With Kiley in the saddle, Just N Time swept the junior exhibitor park saddle ranks at the prestigious New England Morgan Regional. The team then traveled to Jubilee where they were crowned the Park Saddle Junior Exhibitor Reserve Grand Champions. Their final junior exhibitor appearances came in Oklahoma City, where they scored 30 more points on the Morgan breed's biggest stage.

AW Global Vision GCH's transition to the park saddle ranks proved successful, as the son of Continental Vision earned not only a world title but the reserve spot in the Junior Exhibitor Park Saddle High Point Report. Macy Peters campaigned her gelding to net 97 points from four outings, under the direction of the Indian Creek Farm team. Together, Macy Peters and Global Vision swept the junior exhibitor park saddle ranks at Jubilee Regional. They then scored a reserve grand national title before earning the roses as the Park Saddle Junior Exhibitor World Champions.

JUNIOR HORSE PARK SADDLE

Newmont's French Bellboy amassed an impressive resume and a total of 126 points at the top of the park saddle junior horse leaderboard. The HVK Bell Flaire sired youngster excelled at three horse shows under the Broadmoor banner with owner Kimberly Cramer in the saddle. French Bellboy marched off as the Park Saddle Junior Horse Grand Champion at both New England Morgan and New York Morgan. He then added to his total with the reserve streamers as the Park Saddle Four-Year-Old Reserve World Champion.

A grand total of 102 points sent ICA Daredevil into the reserve spot on the park saddle junior horse rankings. The Merriehill After Hours GCH sired entry made park saddle junior horse rounds of honor with trainer Shea Zepke in the saddle at Indiana Spring Classic, Bonnie Blue, and Blue Ridge. Breeder and owner Megan Buckley also had her turn with her homebred for top ribbons at Gold Cup, Jubilee, and in the park saddle four-year-old ranks at the Morgan Grand National.

NS Fame & Fortune once again celebrated a stellar park harness season, culminating with the top spot on the open park harness leaderboard. The Roberto Cavalli sired entry garnered 94 points from two horse shows with Jim Taylor on the lines. Leslie and Darris Garoufalas are the proud owners of this athletic performer who began his season with a sweep of the open park harness ranks at New England Regional, including the title of the Park Harness East Coast Grand Champion. Fame & Fortune then marched to Oklahoma City where he was crowned the Park Harness Reserve World Champion for the second consecutive year.

EKL Shakedown has amassed a growing fan club who were delighted with the stallion's performances on his way to the reserve placement on the open park harness leaderboard. The Centerpiece sired stallion earned a total of 70 points in just three outings with owner and trainer Alicia Owens handling the presentation duties. Shakedown's undefeated season included a victory pass as the Morgan Park Harness winner at the Mid-Atlantic Showcase. He then starred at the Morgan Grand National as the Park Harness Grand National Champion and repeated his 2021 results as the Park Harness World Champion for the second consecutive year.

LADIES PARK HARNESS

Springmill Superstition GCH has been a familiar name at the top of the ladies park harness leaderboard and once again found himself there in 2022. A grand total of 100 points propelled the son of Nostradamus into the first place spot after appearances at three horse shows. Julianne Rafferty headed up this gelding who made four victory passes in his four ladies outings in the show ring. With Leesa Galatz on the lines, Superstition was the Park Harness Ladies winner at New England Morgan and Jubilee Regional. He also was named the Park Harness Ladies Grand National Champion before being crowned the Park Harness Ladies World Champion for the fourth time.

Winsome Hills Coolchatter teamed up with new owner Marina Abrams in 2022 under the direction of Selvin Torrez. Their success resulted in the reserve position on the ladies park harness leaderboard with a total of 63 points. The Cool Whip sired athlete claimed the reserve honors from the park harness ladies division at Jubilee Regional. With Abrams on the lines, he then continued his campaign at the Morgan Grand National, garnering 45 points there including the third place prize in the Park Harness Ladies World Championship.

AMATEUR PARK HARNESS

Get Out and Christine Matthews had a busy and successful season under the Broadmoor banner. The Get Busy sired performer claimed the top spot on the Amateur Park Harness High Point Report with a total of 129 points from six classes. Get Out made park harness amateur victory passes at Southern States and New England Morgan and also received the reserve tricolor as New England's Park Harness Amateur Reserve Grand Champion. While in Oklahoma City, Matthews drove Get Out to spotlight honors as the Park Harness Amateur Reserve World Champion.

Deborah Hamilton made the wise decision to purchase Firewind Kakewalk and transition the gelding back to the park harness ranks mid-season. Their efforts, with the help of the Taylor River Farm team, resulted in Kakewalk's reserve spot on the amateur park harness leaderboard. Hamilton drove the BKC Valiant Star sired Firewind Kakewalk to 28 points in New England's competitive amateur division before sweeping the junior exhibitor/amateur ranks at Massachusetts Morgan. They then excelled at the highest level as the Park Harness Amateur Masters Grand National Champions and secured 15 more points in the Park Harness Amateur World Championship.

He then showcased his talents in Oklahoma City to claim the third place prize in the junior exhibitor harness qualifier as well as the reserve world title in the Park Harness Junior Exhibitor World Championship.

Clayhill Dillinger climbed to the reserve position on the junior exhibitor park harness leaderboard after just one show and two outings. Emma DuCoeur piloted her Mizrahi sired teammate in their first season together. With guidance from the Fire Run Farm team, Dillinger garnered 57 points with DuCoeur on the lines. Together, they were named the Park Harness Junior Exhibitor World Champions as well as the Park Harness Junior Exhibitor 17 and Under Reserve Grand National Champions.

JUNIOR HORSE PARK HARNESS

CRMS Blinding Lights excelled with three different drivers in 2022 that all helped him garner the top spot on the park harness junior horse leaderboard with 94 points. King-E Otto B is the proud sire of this youngster who began his season as the Park Harness Four-Year-Old winner and the Park Harness Junior Horse Grand Champion at Connecticut Morgan with Michael Murphy. Kathleen Jensen then took over the driving assignments, piloting the entry to two top three finishes at New England Morgan. Nikki Rae Woodworth was the final driver to team up with John Durkin's Blinding Lights in 2022. She added 42 points with a pair of fourth place prizes in the park harness four-year-old ranks in Oklahoma City.

Two youngsters tied for the second place spot on the junior horse ranking with a total of 80 points. In just his first year in the show ring, JMJM Mr. Jenson captured the reserve honors from his appearances at two horse shows. Will Vidler is the trainer of Jo Ann Ward's HRL Super Star Captivator sired entry. In his show ring debut, Mr. Jenson was crowned the Park Harness Junior Horse Grand Champion at New England Regional, after also securing the red ribbon in

the junior horse qualifier. He also finished the season with 42 points in Oklahoma City in the park harness four-year-old ranks.

IBA Shall We Dance's undefeated season launched her into a tie in the reserve spot with 80 points. Holliston Stables LLC owns this daughter of CBMF Over The Moon, who was piloted by Mike Goebig. Her first appearance in the show ring resulted in the blue ribbon from the UPHA Park Harness Classic at New England. She then swept the park harness three-year-old division at the Morgan Grand National, claiming both the three-year-old grand national and world championship titles.

His season campaign also included reserve ribbons from Buckeye Morgan and two victory passes from Michigan Morgan Breeders.

Muy Bien followed in the reserve spot on the open English pleasure leaderboard with 115 total points. Tamara Moravec is the proud owner of yet another entry that earned a top spot on this season's High Point Report. Sired by Pondview Tres Bien, Muy Bien was piloted in the open division by Moravec as well as Brooke Yule-Gronau and Cierra Holtz. He swept these ranks at Diamond Jubilee and Charity Fair and claimed additional open wins at Carousel Charity, Santa Barbara National, Morgan Medallion and Jingle Bell.

Long Live The Queen CH was still eligible for the junior horse ranks in 2022, yet she took on the ladies ranks with great success, earning the reserve spot on the leaderboard. Casey McDonald Douglass guided her Rand trained mare to a total of 93 points from seven ladies classes. The daughter of DBA Street Talk was the Morgan English Pleasure Ladies winner in her debut with McDonald Douglass at UPHA Chapter 14 Spring Premiere. This duo also swept the ladies ranks at Connecticut Morgan before earning additional reserve honors at both New England Regional and Massachusetts Morgan. She brought her talents to Oklahoma City where she was awarded with the title of the English Pleasure Ladies Mare Reserve Grand National Champion.

Together they were the victors at UPHA Chapter 14 Spring Premiere, Connecticut Morgan, Summer Kick Off, and Massachusetts Morgan. They were the English Pleasure Saddle Amateur Reserve Grand Champions at New England and also added a world title to their resume as the English Pleasure Amateur Masters Reserve World Champions.

Stablemate Indian Creek Seahorse Sam finished just one point behind Queen's Dream Girl on the amateur leaderboard with 156 points. Sired by Dragonsmeade Sea Dragon, Seahorse Sam was partnered for the first time this season with Cecilia Bergeron Allen. They scored reserve honors in the amateur ranks from UPHA Chapter 14 Spring Premiere and Connecticut Morgan and made victory passes at Summer Kick Off and Massachusetts Morgan. While at New England Morgan, Allen and her gelding garnered dual third place prizes before concluding their season at the Morgan Grand National. It was there where this duo was crowned the English Pleasure Amateur Masters 50-60 Grand National Champions and earned the yellow streamers in the competitive English Pleasure Amateur Masters World Championship.






AMATEUR WESTERN PLEASURE
