ROADSTER, HACKNEY & FRIESIAN HIGH POINT REPORT

OPEN ROADSTER TO BIKE

Here We Go soared into the top spot in the open roadster to bike High Point Report. Danette Musselman and Dr. Mark Picoro teamed up with this son of Dominator, who excelled in just his second year in the show ring. Here We Go netted 200 points with Musselman in the bike. Their journey together in 2022 included open roadster to bike wins from IASHA Spring Warm Up, Big D Charity, Lawrenceburg KY, Mercer County Fair, the All American Horse Classic, and Mane Event. In his first ever trip to Louisville, Here We Go left Freedom Hall as the Ladies Roadster To Bike Section One World's Champion. He concluded his year at the UPHA/American Royal, topping the Open Roadster To Bike qualifier and earning the reserve streamers in the prestigious UPHA Roadster To Bike Classic Grand Championship.

Debbie Foley is notorious for her talents with road horses and didn't disappoint in 2022 with newcomer Happy Trails Sonny. The Son Of Grace sired entry represented Twin Ash Equine LLC in the reserve spot on the open road horse leaderboard with 193 points. Debbie Foley was in the bike to direct Happy Trails Sonny to the sweep of the open roadster to bike division at Shelbyville and ASHAV. The speedster also secured wins from Midwest Charity and Blue Ridge. He excelled at the highest levels as the Roadster To Bike Stallion/Gelding World's Champion and the Roadster To Bike Reserve World's Grand Champion. Kansas City was Happy Trails Sonny's final stop for the season. While there, he topped the inaugural Standardbred Roadster 100 and left the horse show as the Roadster To Bike National Champion.

AMATEUR ROADSTER TO BIKE

I've Got This and Debra Clark stepped it up a notch to cinch the leading spot on the amateur roadster to bike High Point Report. Jon Walker directed this Muscle Massive sired entry to 195 points from six horse shows. Clark and her teammate sped off as the Amateur Roadster To Bike Grand Champions from J.D. Massey, Asheville Saddlebred Classic, and Blowing Rock. They additionally claimed the reserve streamers from the amateur championship at Blue Ridge and Ocala. Clark and I've Got This saved some of their best performances for Louisville-leaving the green shavings as the Amateur Roadster To Bike Section Two World's Champion before scoring the fourth place prize in the amateur championship.

The always competitive amateur division included a tie for the reserve spot on the High Point Report between Genesis and Zoom-both with 173 points. Genesis was part of Susan Swope's talented show string under the direction of Peter and Kim Cowart. The Angus Hall sired campaigner swept the amateur roadster to bike division at Shenandoah and claimed additional reserve prizes from Gasparilla Charity, Asheville Saddlebred Classic, and Ocala-all with Swope in the silks. This pair excelled in Freedom Hall, being crowned the Amateur Roadster To Bike Section Three World's Champions en route to the third place prize in the amateur championship.

Zoom tied with Genesis in the reserve spot on the amateur High Point Report. Stephanie and Chris Brannan directed this aptly named speedster and her driver Stuart Bennett through their 13 appearances. Bennett and the Mr. Cantab sired entry were named the Amateur Roadster To Bike Reserve Grand Champions at J.D. Massey, and the All American Horse Classic and claimed additional top ribbons from Asheville, Rock Creek, Blue Ridge, and ASHAV. They finished fourth in Louisville's Amateur Roadster To Bike Section Two offering and ended their season at the UPHA/American Royal as the Amateur Roadster To Bike Reserve National Champions.

ROADSTER TO WAGON

Indian Outlaw has long excelled in the roadster to wagon division and finished in the top spot on the wagon High Point Report for the remarkable third consecutive year. Sisters Melissa and Melinda Moore teamed up with this son of Winand who secured 123 points. With Melissa Moore on the lines, Indian Outlaw was the Roadster To Wagon victor at Kentucky Spring Premier, Midwest Charity, Lexington Junior League, and Kentucky Fall Classic. He also picked up the fourth place ribbon in Freedom Hall from the Open Roadster To Wagon Stake and later in the week, carried off the third place honors in the Roadster To Wagon Championship with Melinda Moore.

Hawker 850 landed in the reserve position on the wagon leaderboard with 86 points from just two horse shows. Scott Hagan guided his Neely Dunn sired partner under the direction of Kristen Bagdasarian, beginning with the tricolor from Midwest Charity as the Roadster To Wagon Grand Champions. They then brought their talents to the World's Championship Horse Show where Hagan and Hawker were crowned the Open Roadster To Wagon Reserve World's Champions before finishing fourth in the wagon championship.

ROAD HORSE UNDER SADDLE

Live Wire's 2022 success resulted in the leading position on the road horse under saddle High Point Report. Dr. Holly Ackerman is the proud owner and rider of this son of Edelsteen, who secured 217 points. Live Wire scored victories throughout the year with multiple riders including Ackerman along with Lillia Shope, Mary Lou Carrick, Reagan Upton, and Dr. Brian Garrett—a testament to the entry's talents and the training of Chris Carrick. He swept the roadster under saddle ranks at Capital City Classic, Asheville Summer Fun, ASHAV, and Clemson Fall Classic and garnered additional impressive placings from Asheville Saddlebred Classic, Blue Ridge, Carolina Summer Circuit Championship and NC State Fair Horse Show. Live Wire's season also excelled in a trio of classes in Louisville, ending his week in Freedom Hall with the sixth place prize in the Roadster Under Saddle Championship.

Yet another of Susan Swope's roadsters, Hollywood Boulevard, netted a spot on the High Point Report. The Dondersteen sired entry was guided by Peter, Kim, and Camille Cowart to 174 points and the reserve position on the roadster under saddle leaderboard. Camille Cowart and Susan Swope shared the riding assignments of Hollywood Boulevard, who was crowned the Roadster Under Saddle Grand Champion at Asheville Saddlebred Classic and claimed the reserve streamers from both J.D. Massey and Shenandoah. He secured dual yellow ribbons in Louisville and captured another third place prize in the Roadster Under Saddle Championship in Ocala.

OPEN ROAD PONY

In the open road pony division, it was Midnite Princess to score the top spot on the leaderboard with 193 points from six horse shows. Charlotte Wrather's Regal's Showman LF sired mare excelled with both Abel Salazar and Andy Freseth in the bike. Midnite Princess swept the open road pony ranks at Southern Saddlebred Spring Fling, Madison Classic, and Blue Ridge. She was the Road Pony Grand Champion at Midwest Charity and earned an additional victory pass at Kentucky Fall Classic. The pony also succeeded at the highest level in Louisville. She carried off the honors as the Road Pony 50 Inches & Under Stake World's Champion before ending her week as the Road Pony Reserve World's Grand Champion.

Last year's leading High Point Report pony, Unexpected 2, had to settle for the reserve spot in 2022. Jack Tatum III's Heartland Head Of The Class sired mare scored 150 points from five shows with Georgia Blevins on the lines. The pony celebrated an undefeated year with eight victory passes in eight classes. Unexpected 2 made road pony rounds of honor at J.D. Massey, River Ridge, and Midwest Charity. She next was announced as the Road Pony Over 50 Inches To 52 Inches World's Champion en route to the roses as the Road Pony World's Grand Champion. Her final show ring appearances came at the UPHA/American Royal, garnering the tricolor as the Road Pony National Champion after also topping the Open Road Pony qualifier.

AMATEUR ROAD PONY

Yet another Heartland Head Of The Class sired entry, Heartland Seriously, cinched the top spot on the amateur road pony High Point Report with 246 points. Kathy Capsuto donned her silks to pilot her pony through a busy season with 10 total horse shows. Heartland Seriously was the Amateur Road Pony victor at Shelby County Fair, Lexington Junior League, and

Kentucky Fall Classic and garnered other top ribbons at shows throughout the country. Seriously and Capsuto stormed onto the green shavings where they finished the week as the Amateur Road Pony Reserve World's Champion of Champions and amateur 50 in & under reserve world's champion. This duo capped their successful season with the tricolor as the Amateur Road Pony National Champions after also topping the amateur qualifier at the UPHA/American Royal.

Heartland American Idol and Lynda St. Andre concluded their first season together in the reserve spot on the amateur road pony leaderboard. This Cater Stables trained team garnered 224 points after success at eight horse shows. St. Andre and her Twin Willow's McMillan sired entry swept the amateur road pony division at Raleigh Spring Premier, Bonnie Blue, Devon, and Blue Ridge. They earned third place finishes at UPHA Chapter 14 Spring Premiere and Shenandoah before capturing a world's title as the Amateur Road Pony Over 50 To 52 Inches Section Two World's Champion. St. Andre and her pony continued their success at the UPHA/American Royal with the reserve streamers as the Amateur Road Pony Reserve National Champions.

JUNIOR ROAD PONY

Mary Gise and Andy Freseth have been linked to a myriad of successful horses and ponies. They teamed up with In A Flash who finished the year at the top of the junior road pony rankings with 142 points. Gise's son of Wait & See's Prairie Fire excelled in his first full season in the show ring with Freseth on the lines. He was the UPHA Road Pony Classic winner at Madison Classic and Kentucky Fall Classic and garnered reserve honors at Midwest Charity and Blue Ridge. While in Louisville, In A Flash left with the fifth place ribbon from the Three-Year-Old Road Pony class and carried off the prestigious title of the AHHS National Breeders Futurity Three-Year-Old Road Pony victor at the All American Horse Classic.

Anticipation's Investigator LF's first season in the road pony division concluded with the reserve position on the junior road pony High Point Report. The Mastercraft's Anticipation LF sired pony represented Golden Creek Farm with 98 points earned at three horse shows. Tom Lowry drove this pony to the UPHA Road Pony Classic top honors at Midwest Charity as well as an additional reserve ribbon at Lexington Junior League. His most impressive finishes came in Louisville where Lowry and Investigator were named the Four-Year-Old Road Pony World's Champions and Junior Road Pony World's Champion of Champions.

ROAD PONY UNDER SADDLE

Alex Nester struck again, this time topping the road pony under saddle High Point Report aboard CH Hightower. Janelle D'Amato was once again the winning trainer of this pony, sired by Twentieth Century. This pair's 2022 show ring success resulted in a strong 277 points from 15 horse shows. Nester and CH Hightower captured the tricolor and were named the Road Pony Under Saddle Grand Champions from ASAC, Raleigh Spring Premier, J.D. Massey Classic, The Dixie Cup, Southern States, Blowing Rock, ETSA Midsummer Classic, Alabama Charity Championship and Dallas Fall Classic. They sped off with additional blue ribbons from the AHHS Youth Medallion Hackney Road Pony Under Saddle offerings and garnered the seventh place finish against the best in the world in Louisville's Junior Exhibitor Road Pony Under Saddle Section Two class.

Ellie Riva and Cocked N Ready continued their partnership in 2022 under the direction of Luman Wadhams. Riva and her spicy LLF Top Of The Mark sired pony finished the year with 164 points in the reserve position on the road pony under saddle rankings. This powerful duo swept the road pony under saddle division at UPHA Chapter 14 Spring Premiere and Devon and were additionally the Road Pony Under Saddle Grand Champions at Bonnie Blue. They brought home a world's title from Louisville as the Junior Exhibitor Road Pony Under Saddle Section One Reserve World's Champions and picked up the yellow ribbon in the road pony under saddle championship. Riva and Cocked N Ready's final appearance of the season resulted in the reserve streamers from Ocala's Road Pony Under Saddle Championship.

He made an additional victory pass at Midwest Charity and earned top ribbons from Kentucky Spring Premier, Dogwood Classic, and River

Ridge. The pony also scored dual fourth place finishes from the open Hackney Pony division in Louisville.

Velvateen's sensational year landed the mare in the reserve position on the open Hackney Pony leaderboard with 181 points. Karen Waldron and the Bent Tree Farm teamed up with this daughter of Par Excellence, who made a victory pass at every show she attended. Velvateen made the victory pass as the Hackney Pony Grand Champion at Devon and Syracuse International and earned additional wins from Bonnie Blue, Blue Ridge, North Carolina State Championship, and Ocala. The X-Treme sired pony scored 135 points from seven horse shows with Trethaway on the lines. Together, this pair were named the Amateur Hackney Pony Reserve Grand Champions at Gasparilla Charity and Ocala. They made victory passes at both Blowing Rock and Asheville Summer Fun and scored additional top prizes from J.D. Massey and Asheville Saddlebred Classic.

Nester and his The Chosen One sired pony finished the year with 216 total points from 19 classes. They were the AHHS Youth Medallion Hackney Road Pony victors at J.D. Massey and the North Carolina State Championship and made junior exhibitor road pony victory passes at The Dixie Cup, Southeastern Charity, Alabama Charity Championship, and Clemson Fall Classic. Nester and his swift moving pony added to their total points with additional impressive ribbons from horse shows throughout the country including the third place prize from Freedom Hall in the Junior Exhibitor Road Pony 13 and Under Championship.

Adri Witmer continued the success of the Witmer sisters on the High Point Report, finishing in reserve on the junior exhibitor road pony leaderboard with Regal's Masterpiece LF. Bret Day and the Grey Ridge team directed Witmer and her Dun Haven Regal Attraction sired pony to 208 points earned at eight horse shows. This pair earned multiple rounds of honor from the junior exhibitor ranks at River Ridge, Bonnie Blue, and Blowing Rock. They claimed additional victories from Kentucky Spring Premier and North Carolina State Championship, ultimately making 10 rounds of honor in their 14 trips to the show ring. Witmer and Monarch's season was highlighted with the titles of the Junior Exhibitor Road Pony 13 and Under Reserve World's Champion of Champions from Louisville and the AHHS Youth Medallion Road Pony 13 and Under National Champions from the UPHA/American Royal.

Majestic Oaks and James and Holly Nichols rejoiced in the success of this son of LLF Top Of The Mark who made 10 victory passes in his 12 trips to the show ring in 2022. With Holly Nichols on the lines, Bejeweled swept the open harness pony ranks at Midwest Charity, Lexington Junior League, and St. Louis National Charity. They made additional victory passes at Kentucky Spring Premier, J.D. Massey, and ARHPA. This team's most impressive finishes came in Louisville as the Harness Pony Reserve World's Grand Champions and in Kansas City as the Harness Pony National Champions.

The Bent Tree Farm struck again, this time with Kilbro's Unimagineable, who secured the reserve position on the open harness pony leaderboard. The son of Kilbro's Image finished the year with 193 points from 14 classes. Bryan Earehart piloted this pony to sweep the open division at Bonnie Blue, Devon, and Syracuse International. He made a victory pass at Blue Ridge and was named the Harness Pony Stallion/Gelding Reserve World's Champion in Louisville. Unimagineable next traveled to North Carolina State Championship where he was the Open Harness Pony victor and the Harness Pony Reserve Grand Champion. He earned an additional reserve tricolor from Ocala to conclude his season.
